

Brown County ARES/RACES Net Script

Good evening. This is KC9PGH, calling the Brown County ARES/RACES Net.

My name is Jeff I'm located near the intersection of Mason and Edgewood on Green Bay's far east side. I will be your net control station tonight.

This net meets every Sunday evening at twenty hundred hours or 8:00 p.m. local time on the 147.120 MHz repeater with a PL tone of 107.2. This is a directed net. All amateur radio operators are invited to check in. The purpose of this net is to provide training, equipment checks and share information.

A reminder, the Brown County ARES/RACES meeting is held the 3rd Wednesday of each month. The meeting is at 7:00 p.m. at the State Agriculture Extension Building 1150 Bellevue Street in Green Bay. New members are always welcome.

Those stations with emergency traffic can break in at any time. Any stations with emergency or priority traffic or announcements, please call KC9PGH Net Control now.

We will now take general check-ins. You do not need to be an ARES/RACES member to check in. When checking in please respond with your call using phonetics. Please speak slowly and clearly. Please also include your name, location, and whether or not you have traffic.

Any low power or portable stations wishing to check in please call KC9PGH Net Control now. *(Do a second go around for low power stations after they check-in)*
(Log ALL stations checking in)

Any mobile or fixed stations wishing to check in to the Brown County ARES RACES net please call KC9PGH Net Control now.
(Log ALL stations checking in)

I will go down the list of all previous check-ins for comments and/or traffic.

(Go through the list taking low power or portable stations first. Pause every five check-ins for further stations wishing to check in.)

That completes this portion of the Net. If there are any other stations wishing to check in to the Brown County ARES/RACES net, please call KC9PGH Net Control.

At this time we will be conducting our simplex test, so at this time I will switch to _____ *(pick a frequency below)* and see if the frequency is clear. We also ask that you please lower your squelch and change frequencies to _____.

(Some simplex frequencies from which to choose).:

I will call each person who checked into the regular net. Please respond when I call your name and call sign. Following the simplex test, we will return to the repeater to close the net. Please change to _____ simplex.

(Check on last time after test to see if any other stations wish to check in.)

Is there any further business for tonight's net? (Further Check-ins?)
